SRF was notified that a charity is going to Syria to help set up an Islamic Library for the Syrians. Therefore we took this opportunity and sent Tajweed Qur'ans, Qaida's, Surah Baqarah only Qur'ans and a number of Arabic books.

The SRF Books Team also reached to those forgotten Muslims in Prison. A large number of Islamic books and English translation Qur'ans were sent to a prison in North England. As a prisoner, time in prison is an ideal time to change to a new way of life, what better way of life is there other than Islam? Therefore SRF dispatched over 70 books and 20 English translation Qurans in the hope that it will change the lives of prisoners and draw them closer to Allah inshaAllah.

Water Project Complete

Within a few hours of launching the Congo Water project the target was raised and funds were sent the same day, Al-hamdulillah. The project is now complete and the poor people from surrounding villages have begun drinking those drops of fresh clean water.
